

**Minutes of the S. E. Trek Fun Club Rally  
Clermont Fl. January 31 – February 3, 2008

The February 2, 2008 meeting was called to order by President, John McHale

John introduced the officers and also asked the new members to each introduce themselves.

Minutes of the previous meeting at Myrtle Beach were read and accepted.

The treasurer's report was accepted as presented.

The Club Guidelines were discussed. The following changes were made to the guidelines:

Membership:

- a) The term member is defined herein as resident(s) of a motor coach with a current membership in the FMCA.
- b) Members shall be owners of a Trek. Previous owners if a Trek may continue their membership in the Club regardless of the brand of motor home. A member of another Trek Fun Club must document their previous or current Trek Fun Club association if they are owners of some other brand.

Voting: This was not changed. There will continue to be one vote per "Family Unit"

Duration of Officer Terms:

- a) The Secretary/Treasurer may volunteer for multiple consecutive terms of office. (This was a change from "two consecutive one year terms")

Minutes on the Web Site:

There was a very long discussion before this was resolved.

Madeline Schminke made a motion that we contact everyone in the club one time by snail mail to determine how they wish to receive the minutes and news from the club. Carl Lamb seconded. This motion was defeated.

Carolyn McHale made a motion, seconded by Claire. I move that we contact all members and ask how they wish to be contacted with Club business. This was defeated.

Dave Watkins made a motion. I move that all minutes minutes, newsletters, all meeting agenda and club rally information be posted on the club's web site. Seconded by Diane Sherman. This motion passed. This closed the discussion of the Guideline changes

Concerning the request of M/M Wells who owns a Holiday Rambler Traveler to join the club.

The Wells had been invited to this rally but did not attend. Al Cooper contacted them personally. They will not be considered for membership at this time.

President John McHale asked for a report from the nominating committee.

Jim Fisher reported that the nominating committee recommended that the present

officers remain in office for another year. The recommendation was accepted.

John asked for volunteers to host upcoming rallies.

Spring Rally. No one volunteered at this time to host a Spring Rally.

Fall Rally: The Fall Rally will be hosted by Claire Weston, Jim and Janice Fisher and Dave and Audrey Watkins. The rally will be in Flat Rock, N C Sept 25-28, 2008

Winter Rally:

A volunteer is needed to host the rally. John has contacted Lazy Days Rally Park near Tampa. The rate would be \$34/day for 20-50 coaches. The rally tentative dates are 2/1-2/4/2009.

Bob Davis stated that he would like the rally to be held again at Clerbrook Campground, Clermont

There was a discussion about the possibility of the Trek Fun Club becoming a chapter of FMCA. Hugh Williams made a motion to table the idea at this time. Motion passed unanimously.

Larry Hasiak spoke about his work and that of others work on the Habitat Home Build going on in Ocala. A show of hands indicated great interest in doing something similar. Larry volunteered to contact Safari International and Habitat and find out more about such and undertaking at one of our rallies.

John thanked Dave Watkins for his work on the web site.
